

Harvey Clyde Melick, Jr. (August 2, 1937 - December 19, 1990)

Harvey Clyde Melick, Jr. was born on Monday, August 2, 1937. Clyde graduated from Wantagh High School (Wantagh, New York) in 1956. Clyde graduated from Princeton University in 1960.

Clyde Melick worked many years for LTV Aerospace & Defense Company, as Design Engineering Manager of SRHIT (Small Radar Homing Intercept Technology, the forerunner to the ASAT Anti-Satellite program and the PAC-3 Patriot Advanced Capability anti-missile hit-to-kill missile). Clyde was tragically hit and killed by a car while bicycling on a country road in Mansfield, TX on Wednesday, December 19, 1990. LTV, to honor his contributions, named a Conference Room in Building 60 (the PAC-3 building) for him -- the Melick Conference Room.

Interment: Shiloh Cemetery, in Ovilla, TX.
