Dear Members of the Great Class of 1960,

This has been a very turbulent year, not only because of the Pandemic, but currently dealing with the Delta Variant. It seems that many are still not vaccinated, and the case load nationally continues to rise again. Campus activities will remain virtual for some months.

The good news for us is that the University is now back open with some restrictions. Everything is not clearly normal, but it is a start!

Much of what has happened within the University has been covered already in the *PAW*. There is in addition good news. Starting this fall, there will be Athletic events for all teams! And attendance is allowed! The Harvard Game, October 23, will be considered as "Homecoming". Some Classes will be gathering at their Eating Clubs. Masks will be required except while eating and drinking. You should check with your own eating club for details! Tickets for the football games can be purchased through the ticket office or at the Stadium. As of now, there is no scheduled gathering event for 1960.

Specific items of news are that the renovations of the Archives at Mudd Library have been completed. Regarding Reunions next year, due to changes in the academic calendar, they are scheduled for May 19-22. Alumni Day and the Service of Remembrance is now scheduled for February 19, 2022. A pre-alumni day luncheon is usually held at Prospect House. This has not yet been scheduled. Further details to be announced.

Our Treasurer, Bob Sebring, noted at the end of April 2021, that our Class had a percentage of 52.93% (252/478) of dues payers. As our Class numbers diminish, not surprisingly and sadly, this is an excellent response. The Class of 1960 has given \$15,003 total to the Daniel M. Sachs Scholarship and the Class of 1960 Memorial Scholarship. This is in addition to our regular Class dues and Annual Giving. Enclosed with this Letter is the request for annual dues.

All of these dates are subject to change due to University policy and the behavior of the Virus and the Delta Variant. It would appear at least that the fall Athletic schedule is reliably stated!

I hope all of you are safely coming through the onslaught of the effects of natural disasters such as the western fires, the severe storms affecting the Gulf Coast, and national increase in the number of tornados, the flooding, the draught in the mid-west, and with Covid and the Delta Variant adding to this. Then escalating division of our country politically resulting in acrid and often venomous exchanges is worrisome and hurtful. These are not easy times.

When on campus, don't forget to view the stone memorial from the Class of 1960 on the back wall of the Chapel. Thanks to Rich McGlynn for co-ordinating this project.
