PATRICK DAVIS died on Feb. 17 in Winston-Salem, N.C. He had been in poor health for the past few years and was unable to return for Reunions, though he maintained a long-standing interest in the university.

Early in his career at college, Pat was stricken with polio, which prevented his continuing with our class. Although he entered Princeton in the fall of 1956, having graduated from the Taft School, he was on campus only until Christmas of that year. His illness was sudden and he spent the spring of 1957 in an iron lung, which was followed by a rehabilitation period at Warm Springs, Ga. He was confined to a wheelchair for the remaining years of his life. He continued his education at Univ. of Illinois and joined the family firm in Erie, moving with it to Winston-Salem in 1962. Pat is survived by a son and daughter, his parents, two brothers, and his paternal grandmother. The Class of 1960 extends its warmest sympathy to the members of his family.
