As you know, annual dues do more than just support your subscription to the *Princeton Alumni Weekly (PAW)*. They also provide an opportunity to contribute to the Daniel M. Sachs Class of 1960 Graduating Scholarship Fund, as well as the Class of 1960 Memorial Scholarship Fund for undergraduates. I am happy to report that to date this year, we have received \$5,590 for the Memorial fund and \$4,225 for the Dan Sachs fund, as well as \$4,235 for the Class.
