



Together we have succeeded! 1960 has once again made its mark - this time producing generous support for Princeton in our 50th Reunion Annual Giving Campaign.

- We raised a total of **\$3,677,060!** This is \$1.5 million more than our previous best of \$2.15 million at the 40th. The Class of 1960 Challenge Fund inspired many classmates to make their largest gift ever to Princeton.
- We succeeded because of the breadth and depth of the Class effort. 9 generous guys gave \$100,000 or more and 22 others gave \$25,000 or more. Most importantly, a total of 71 classmates stepped up to the “Special Gift” level of \$10,000 or more which is a class record for the highest number of \$10k gifts ever received.
- 60 new donors were added from last year to this year and participation jumped over 10 percentage points.
- We raised the cumulative total of our Annual Giving support as a class since graduation to \$14,954,389.
- We reached **80.6%** participation with gifts from 490 classmates! 80.6% is the highest participation rate from 1951-2009 (*major reunions and off years*). It is also ahead of '57's 50th participation (80.3%), '58's 50th participation (77.6%) and '59's 50th participation (75.4%). Lastly, 80.6% is above the ten year average 50th participation of 79.5%.

Thank you for the important part that you played in this wonderful performance. Our collective generosity enables Princeton to continue to lead and to serve.
